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Discharge Instructions after Brain Surgery

- 1. Get plenty of rest each day. It is natural to become easily fatigued during your recovery so you may wish to rest in the afternoon.
- 2. Avoid heavy exercise, lifting over 20 lbs., bending, twisting, or stooping.
- 3. DO NOT DRIVE UNLESS CLEARED TO DO SO BY YOUR PHYSICIAN.
- 4. Contact us should you develop **fever**, **wound redness**, **discharge** from your incision, **worsening headache**, **increased drowsiness**, **increased confusion**, **nausea**, **vomiting**, **stiff neck**, **double vision**, **seizures**, **weakness of one side**, **or worsening speech**.
- 5. Keep wound clean and dry and change dressing if stained.
- 6. **DO NOT** stop any seizure medications unless advised by your doctor.
- 7. Allow **72 HOURS** for renewal of all prescribed medications before you run out.
- 8. **Do not** shower until the 5th day after surgery. **Do not** use hair dyes or chemicals for 6 weeks.
- 9. Call our office to set up a follow up appointment if you do not have one already scheduled. A visit for a wound check is routinely done **7 14 days** after surgery. Contact our office at (916) 771-3300 if you have any questions.
